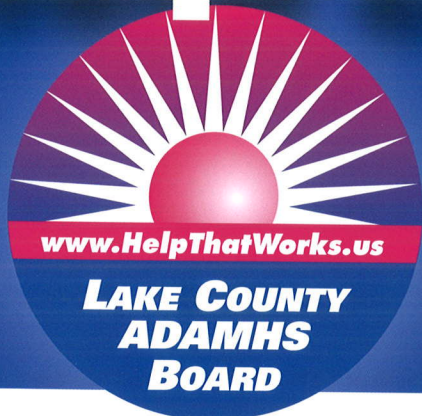


# Help that works.
