- A licensed crisis clinician will assess a person and determine the level of intervention needed in order to restore them to pre-crisis functioning.
- We offer telephone and/or face-to-face intervention. We can meet with a person anywhere in the community or in our agency on a walk-in basis.

WHAT INTERVENTIONS WILL CRISIS TEAM PROVIDE?

- Crisis assessment
- · Short-term counseling
- Consultation with treating psychiatrists and medication monitoring
- Linkage to other mental health treatment and social service providers
- Follow-up support calls
- · Development of crisis plan
